Our Rector writes:

Norwich cathedral will be having a helter skelter installed at the west end of the nave between August 8th-18th. Climbing to the top will give visitors a unique view of the cathedral and reveal the beautiful roof bosses close up, which tell the story of our Creation through to the resurrection. Alongside this, visitors will also be encouraged to use the mats and lie down to look up and see the cathedral from a new perspective. This is not only to see the cathedral differently but also to open up the conversation as to how God can help us see life differently. Trained volunteers will be on hand to help people maximise their experience of finding God.

Life is rather like a helter skelter. We are sometimes climbing up to high places and mountain tops and life looks good and at other times we are down in valleys, challenged by our problems. We don't know when we will find ourselves in either place but the reality of life is that it has its ups and downs and no-one is exempt. However, those of us who believe in a loving God who guides our every movement and loves us, will know that only God has the complete picture. At every moment, he will be there to share our joys and sorrows:

“Rejoice with those who rejoice, weep with those who weep.” (Romans 12:15)

St Paul's words bring us comfort at this time when two former church wardens have died unexpectedly in the space of a few days: Mrs Maureen Kenyon (Stody) and Mrs Ann Ludbrook (Thornage). Maureen worked tirelessly and graciously through the recent interregnum and was pivotal in arranging clergy cover, church rotas, secretarial and admin tasks, setting up the paperwork for my appointment and co-editing our magazine. This she did with humility and a smile, always putting others before her own needs. She became a treasured friend. Both Maureen and Ann would travel to services most Sundays, wherever they happened to take place in our benefice. They both showed a huge amount of faith and a desire to know God better. It was a privilege for me to share that with them. Right up to the day she died, Ann came to church and participated in the worship. Both Maureen and Ann will be sorely missed. May they rest in peace and rise in Glory.

Norfolk Churches Trust Bike Ride Saturday, 14th September

The Norfolk Churches Trust Bike Ride is the widest reaching Norfolk Churches Trust event and involves a large number of people to make it the success that it is. It coordinates raising the money with parishes benefiting directly if they take part. Many people help to make the ride a success; not only the people who take part in the event whether by bike, foot, horse or car but those who sit in the churches, make refreshments, prepare for the day, chivvy folk to get involved and, of course, those who sponsor.

Last year Norfolk Churches Trust Bike Ride raised a massive £91,496 and the event was supported by 541 participants who made 2,808 visits to the county's churches and chapels. This was an increase in the number of the previous year's participants and the number of churches visited!

This year Norfolk Churches Trust wants to draw your attention to a fantastic new competition. They are offering a prize of £1,000 to the church which raises the most amount of money compared to the amount it raised last year. They hope that this will encourage churches that haven't been able to take part to find people to get involved and for those that do take part to get more people involved. This year it takes place on Saturday, 14th September and hopefully it will be a day without rain.

Wells County Division: I now know that Wells Division is shared between the following district wards: Wells and Holkham; Coastal; Priority; Stody; Holt; Walsingham. What has not changed are the nice people and hard working councilors. And I await with interest when next year the county decides what changes it will make to the counties divisions.

Wells-next-the-Sea Recycling Centre Re-use Shop: It was a delight to open the re-use shop at Wells recycling centre - not only being able to present a cheque for £9,470 to the East Anglian Air Ambulance from income generated by existing re-use shops but also to see the enthusiasm of the staff at the centre who are rightly proud of their efforts to bring the shop into operation and ensure more items are re-used than thrown. The County Council's re-use shops welcome donations of good quality second hand pieces and sell these on at bargain car boot prices. Helping to give useful items a new home reduces the amount of unwanted items going to waste and the income from sales in the shops helps to offset the cost of providing the recycling centre service.

Dry Road to Wells: For anyone as curious as I was the red and white poles are marker posts for a gas main. (For visitors and newcomers the Dry Road is the B1105 Wells to Fakenham, historically known as the Dry Road because it was one of the few roads around these parts without a pub.)

Bank Scams: Norfolk County Council Trading Standards has received reports from residents that bank accounts are being opened in their names. Victims received a letter from a bank with information of a new account opened in their name followed by a further letter with a bank card for the account. The victims were not customers of the bank nor had any dealings with the bank. Advice: If you receive such letters contact the bank straight away; keep a record of all conversations you have with the bank and copies of letters referencing the fraud. 

Saturday 21 September 2019

The Glaven Centre invites you to enjoy a choice of fundraising walks through the beautiful Glaven Valley on Saturday 21 September 2019.

Setting off from the Art Café at Glandford, there is a walk for everyone. All routes are dog friendly. A 10k walk follows historic footpaths and bridle paths through the Bayfield Estate, over the Wiveton Downs to the coastal path and back. A gentler but equally glorious 5k circular walk through the Bayfield Estate crosses open farmland, woodland and wetland. Landowner Robin Combe will be on hand to talk about the local bird, insect and plant life. 


